- Halogen lamps
- Hoverboards
- Pets (except fish in a 20-gallon tank or less)
- 3-in-1 laundry sheets
- Wood lofts or cement blocks for lifting beds
- Removable hooks (Command strips)
- Instapots (electric pressure cookers)
- Air Fryers and Toaster/Toaster Ovens
- Adhesive LED light strips
